## Galatians 5:1

*“For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.”*

### I. Freedom -

- The state of being free or at liberty rather than in confinement or under physical restraint
- exemption from external control, interference, regulations, etc.
- the power to determine action without restraint
- personal liberty, as opposed to bondage or slavery
- exemption from the presence of anything specified (usually followed by from) : freedom from fear
- the right to enjoy all the privileges or special rights of citizenship, membership, etc., in a community or the like

Philosophy: the power to exercise choice and make decisions without constraint from within or without; autonomy; self-determination

Synonyms: liberty, opportunity, right, leeway

### II. Slavery

- the condition of a slave; bondage.
- the keeping of slaves as a practice or institution.
- a state of subjection like that of a slave : He was kept in slavery by drugs.
- severe toil; drudgery.

## John 10:10

*“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.”*

### III. Abundantly

- present in great quantity; more than adequate; oversufficient: an abundant supply of water.
- well supplied with something; abounding : a river abundant in salmon.
- richly supplied, as with resources: an abundant land.
